RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.**
2. This Show is run in accordance with the 2022 Rules of the British Show Horse Association.
3. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by the Exhibitors, Riders or their Horses or any other person connected. Entries are accepted on this basis.
4. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if there are insufficient entries, or to amend conditions of any class at their discretion.
5. While every effort will be made to avoid classes clashing, the Show cannot be held responsible if due to large entries classes overrun.
6. Novice classes are open to registered Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs and Riding Horses which have not won a first prize of £35 or more or a total of £250 in any showing classes affiliated to the BSHA, at home or abroad, prior to 1st January in the current year. Winnings gained as a 4 year old are exempt unless the animal has won an Open Ridden class with a first prize of £35 or more. A Novice may be shown in a snaffle bridle. Please see full Novice Rule in current BSHA Rule Book 2022.
7. Amateur Owner/Rider classes are open to registered Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs and Riding Horses as defined in the BSHA Rule Book 2022.
- 8. RULES FOR BSHA RISING STAR CLASSES**

PLEASE ENTER THESE CLASSES IN THE SPIRIT FOR WHICH THEY ARE INTENDED

- Open to Non-Members and BSHA Membership. Owners, Riders and Horses, are not required to be Members of the British Show Horse Association in-order to compete in the BSHA Rising Star qualifying classes, the Rising Star Finals will require a day ticket.
- These classes are specifically aimed at those Horses and Riders who are not regularly qualifying for the major Championship Shows and wish to improve.
- Riders must not have competed at The Royal International Horse Show or The Horse of the Year Show, with the exception of the BSHA RIHS Amateur classes pre-2022 or SEIB Search for a Star.
- Open to Horses which are stabled at home or in a DIY or non-show yard.
- Horses to be ridden by an Amateur, please see the current BSHA Rule Book; this does not exclude receiving lessons from a Professional showing person.
- No Professional is allowed to ride, to work-in (in any form), compete, or enter the Ring to groom/strip the Horse.
- Failure to abide by the Rules may result in ineligibility to compete at the BSHA National Championship Show in any class.
- The Judge will ride ALL the exhibits in the final.
- To register for the Supreme Final at the BSHA National Championships Show on the 10th September you must upload your details on our website using the details on the back of the qualifying rosette.

9. Non-Members may compete in Classes **12, 13, 14, 20, 21, 22, 23, 31**.
10. Non-Members may compete in **non RIHS** qualifying Classes, providing that they have purchased a '**Day Ticket**'; classes **8, 9, 10, 11, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 32, 33**; for further details please contact the office on 01462 437770.
11. **Tattersalls RoR Amateur definition:** The rules are as in the rulebook with the following addition that an amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. In addition a person classed as amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as brand ambassador whether financially or in-kind. An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season: Engage (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity. Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard from January 1st 2021. Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional Producer/Trainer in the current or previous season. Horses and riders must not receive any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current season. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.
12. **IDHS:** The following classes are affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) and only horses registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership are eligible for entry. The owners of all pure bred Irish Draught horses in ridden classes must be full members of the IDHS (GB). This rule does not apply to owners of Irish Draught Sport Horses. Registration numbers to be stated on the entry form and entries will be sent to the IDHS (GB) prior to the Show to confirm eligibility. All competing Stallions must be the progeny of a graded mare (ID Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB) AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) by a Class 1 Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion and be inspected or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and classified as RID (GB), ID Class 1 or ID Class 2 OR be a Registered Irish Draught Sport Horse Stallion, and they must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails. All riders of stallions must be 18 years of age or over. All ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over.
13. Hard hats must be worn at all times whilst riding and leading horses on the showground.
14. **DOGS are allowed on the Showground but MUST be kept on a lead any dog fouling must be cleaned up.**
15. **MUCKING OUT OF HORSESBOXES IS PROHIBITED ON THE SHOWGROUND.**
16. **NO LUNGEING**
17. **CHAMPIONSHIPS – Horses not forward for championships or supremes will forfeit all Prize Money**

RING 1

Open Ridden Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs & Riding Horses Royal International Horse Show (RIHS) Qualifying Classes

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older.

BSHA Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms.

Classes 1 - 7 inclusive are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The First Prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward.

Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

BSHA CLASSIC OF THE YEAR: The 1st or highest placed prize winners in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic of the Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA Hunter & National Championship Shows in September 2022.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse and RIHS Hunter classes).

The Series is open to AMATEURS only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series This class is a qualifier for the Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series FINAL. The Judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the final. The first three go forward to the final to be held at the Hickstead Derby Meeting, June 26th 2022.

- Class 12** **TATTERSALLS RoR AMATEUR RIDDEN SHOW SERIES QUALIFIER 2022** – Open to all RoR and

Class 13 **TATTERSALL RoR OPEN RIDDEN SHOW SERIES QUALIFIER 2022** - Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January 2022. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavasson noseband. Horses should be plaited. **The first THREE go forward to the championship at Hickstead on June 26th 2022.** All entries **MUST** be registered with the RoR and include their competition registration number on entry form and have **RACED in GB.** All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force. Please be aware that the show will split the class on the horse's last run in a race (NH or Flat) or will provide 2 ride judges should the entries exceed 20. Please mark your entry form accordingly. **Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. Racing injuries and blemishes will NOT be ignored in this series.** Prizes : Rosettes 1st - 4th and Vouchers 1st to 3rd place. Veteran prize (15+) - £20 voucher to be redeemed from RoR office and qualification for the Veteran Final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree. RoR prizes will not be awarded to RoR qualifiers with numbers forward of two or less, however qualification for the final will stand. 1st £40 plus RoR prize, 2nd £30, 3rd £20. 1st & 2nd are required for C5 after class 14.

In-Hand Youngstock

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Owners, Handlers & Horses must be registered or have temporary membership with a In-Hand Day Ticket. In-Hand Horses registered with the Association must be Owned by current BSHA Members.

This is a qualifier for the BSHA Polly Coles Supreme In-Hand Breeding Championship, to be held at the BSHA National Championships September 2022, with £1000 to the winner. Champion & Reserve to qualify. The BSHA offer a Qualified rosette to the Champion & Reserve.

The BSHA offer a Owner/Breeder rosette in each In-Hand Breeding class with the exception of the Foal classes, these have been kindly sponsored by the Kellythorpe Stud. All competitors receiving this award should contact the office to register their interest in the Kellythorpe Stud Owner/Breeder Final at the National Championship Show.
