RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.
2. This Show is run in accordance with the 2021 Rules of the British Show Horse Association.
3. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by the Exhibitors, Riders or their Horses or any other person connected. Entries are accepted on this basis.
4. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if there are insufficient entries, or to amend conditions of any class at their discretion.
5. While every effort will be made to avoid classes clashing, the Show cannot be held responsible if due to large entries classes overrun.
6. Novice classes are open to registered Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs and Riding Horses which have not won a first prize of £35 or more or a total of £250 in any showing classes affiliated to the BSHA, at home or abroad, prior to 1st January in the current year. Winnings gained as a 4 year old are exempt unless the animal has won an Open Ridden class with a first prize of £35 or more. A Novice may be shown in a snaffle bridle.
7. Amateur Owner/Rider classes are open to registered Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs and Riding Horses as defined in the BSHA Rule Book 2021.
8. RULES FOR BSHA INTRO CLASSES **
PLEASE ENTER THESE CLASSES IN THE SPIRIT FOR WHICH THEY ARE INTENDED
 - Open to Members who have had up to two years previous Full Membership of the BSHA and Non-Members.
 - Horses & Riders DO NOT have to be members of the BSHA to enter the BSHA Intro Classes.
 - Riders MUST not have competed at HOYS within the last 5 years with the exception of Search for a Star.
 - Open to horse & rider combination not to have won a total of £200 in any showing classes.
 - Horses MUST be stabled at home, DIY or in a non-showing yard.
 - Horses to be ridden by an Amateur as per the BSHA definition.
 - No professional producers are allowed into the Ring or work the horse on the day of competition.
9. Non-BSHA Members may compete in Classes **22, 33-35, 42-46, 48, 8-14, 36-38**
10. Non-Members may compete in non RIHS qualifying Classes, providing that they have purchased a 'Day Ticket'; classes **15-21, 29-32, 23-28, 39-41, 47**; for further details please contact the office on 01462 437770.
11. Hard hats must be worn at all times whilst riding and leading horses on the showground.
12. DOGS are allowed on the Showground but MUST be kept on a lead any dog fouling must be cleaned up.
13. MUCKING OUT OF HORSESBOXES IS PROHIBITED ON THE SHOWGROUND.
14. NO LUNGEING
15. CHAMPIONSHIPS – Horses not forward will forfeit all Prize Money
16. Non-Members may purchase a BSHA Day Ticket from the BSHA website.
17. BSHA membership not required for BSPA, Hunter RoR and Intro classes.
18. ENTRIES CLOSE 20th May on Entrymaster – Entries can be taken on the day at an increase cost by card only

SHB(GB) Affiliated Ridden Hunters

Royal International Horse Show (RIHS) Qualifying Classes

All Hunter Classes will be judged under the SHB (GB) 2021 Society's Rules.

Classes 8 - 147 are qualifying events for the RIHS 2021 and only Horses registered on the SHB(GB) Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and Owners and Riders must be Members of the Society. The two highest placed Horses in classes 8 - 14 will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No Horse lower than second in its Class will qualify.

Day Ticket = £36 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year at £36 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

Competitors in classes 8-14, 44. It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards: All PAS 015; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards; It is mandatory for competitors under the age of 18 to wear such skull caps or hats.
