RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.**
2. This Show is run in accordance with the 2021 Rules of the British Show Horse Association.
3. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by the Exhibitors, Riders or their Horses or any other person connected. Entries are accepted on this basis.
4. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if there are insufficient entries, or to amend conditions of any class at their discretion.
5. While every effort will be made to avoid classes clashing, the Show cannot be held responsible if due to large entries classes overrun.
6. Novice classes are open to registered Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs and Riding Horses which have not won a first prize of £35 or more or a total of £250 in any showing classes affiliated to the BSHA, at home or abroad, prior to 1st January in the current year. Winnings gained as a 4 year old are exempt unless the animal has won an Open Ridden class with a first prize of £35 or more. A Novice may be shown in a snaffle bridle.
7. Amateur Owner/Rider classes are open to registered Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs and Riding Horses as defined in the BSHA Rule Book 2021.
- 8. RULES FOR BSHA INTRO CLASSES ****

PLEASE ENTER THESE CLASSES IN THE SPIRIT FOR WHICH THEY ARE INTENDED

- Open to Members who have had up to two years previous Full Membership of the BSHA and Non-Members.
 - Horses & Riders **DO NOT** have to be members of the BSHA to enter the BSHA Intro Classes.
 - Riders **MUST** not have competed at HOYS within the last 5 years with the exception of Search for a Star.
 - Open to horse & rider combination not to have won a total of £200 in any showing classes.
 - Horses **MUST** be stabled at home, DIY or in a non-showing yard.
 - Horses to be ridden by an Amateur as per the BSHA definition.
 - No professional producers are allowed into the Ring or work the horse on the day of competition.
9. **Non-Members may compete in Classes 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 20.**
 10. Non-Members may compete in **non RIHS** qualifying Classes, providing that they have purchased a 'Day Ticket'; **classes 8, 9, 17, 18, 19**; for further details please contact the office on 01462 437770.
 11. Hard hats must be worn at all times whilst riding and leading horses on the showground.
 12. **DOGS are allowed on the Showground but MUST be kept on a lead any dog fouling must be cleaned up.**
 13. **MUCKING OUT OF HORSESBOXES IS PROHIBITED ON THE SHOWGROUND.**

RING 1

Open Ridden Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs & Riding Horses Royal International Horse Show (RIHS) Qualifying Classes

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older.
BSHA Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms.

Classes 1 - 7 inclusive are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The First Prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes. The three highest placed prize winners in each Open Affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championship Show in September 2021. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse and RIHS Hunter classes).

A Day Ticket can be purchased for £20. 1st and 2nd to qualify for the Owners Championship at the BSHA National Championship Show 2020. Highest placed amateur/home produced exhibitor is required for S2.

BSPA Royal International Horse Show Classes

Classes 13 & 14 are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead 2021. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules. Download from www.bspaonline.com. All horses/ponies must be registered and all owners and riders BSPA members prior to the show. Rider's age taken from 1st January. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cm or under (Shetlands exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate. All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA or hold a BSPA Showing Permit (contact BSPA for Stallion showing permit information) for 2021 and have a BSPA stallion ID card and wear BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class. No competitor / owner / horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2021 Membership of RIHS and a RIHS qualification card. Qualification: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place. BSPA Office: 01354 638226; email: bspashows@gmail.com. Skewbald and Piebald horse / ponies only. Highest placed Amateur and highest placed Junior in each class qualify for Amateur and Junior Supreme Championships Final to be held at the BSPA World of Colour Championship Show 2021. SHB(GB) Affiliated Ridden Hunters

Royal International Horse Show (RIHS) Qualifying Classes

All Hunter Classes will be judged under the SHB (GB) 2021 Society's Rules.

Classes 21 - 27 are qualifying events for the RIHS 2020 and only Horses registered on the SHB(GB) Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and Owners and Riders must be Members of the Society. The two highest placed Horses in classes 22 – 28 will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No Horse lower than second in its Class will qualify.

Day Ticket = £36 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year at £36 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

Competitors in classes 22 – 28. **It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards:**

All PAS 015; VG1; **(BS)EN1384 2017**; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; **SNELL E2016**; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards;

It is mandatory for competitors under the age of 18 to wear such skull caps or hats.
