CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The show is run in accordance with the British Show Horse Association Rules for 2026.
2. No responsibility will be accepted by the Organisers for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by the Exhibitors and/or Riders or their Horses. Entries are accepted on this basis.
3. Classes will not run ahead of schedule but large entries might cause some classes to over-run.
4. **GROOMS:** In classes where Grooms are permitted to enter the Ring during judging, they must be correctly dressed, of smart appearance (no jeans or denim) and wearing headwear.
5. **ANGLO and PART BRED CLASSES:** The In-Hand Anglo and Part Bred Arab classes 66-68 are open to Non-Members of the Association, Horses do not have to qualify, but must be registered with the Arab Horse Society.
6. **NOVICE FLAT CLASSES:** 23-26, 98-105 & 116-118, inclusive are open to registered and unregistered Hunters, Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs and Riding Horses. Novice classes are open to: 4 and 5 yo irrespective of any wins, placings or prize money accrued, unless placed 1st – 5th at HOYS or RIHS in any OPEN Ridden class (with the exception of the Search For A Star Finals), 6 yo or over unless placed 1st – 5th at HOYS or RIHS in any OPEN Ridden class, (with the exception of the Search For A Star Finals) or have won a first prize of £25 or over in any showing class, excluding Working Show Horse Classes, Rising Star classes and finals, Ladies Show Horse or In-Hand classes, that were Affiliated to the Association, at home or abroad, prior to 1st January in the current year.
7. The Organisers reserve the right to make alterations to the published timetable, cancel any class if there are insufficient entries, or to amend the conditions of any class at their absolute discretion. If entries are large it may be necessary to arrange preliminary judging.
8. **DAY TICKETS:** If your class requires a Day Ticket, please tick the box when making your entry online to add the Day Ticket. You do not have to apply for a separate Day Ticket.
9. **REFUND OF ENTRIES: REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN UNLESS A VETERINARY OR DOCTORS CERTIFICATE IS PRODUCED. ALL REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE OFFICE WITHIN 7 WORKING DAYS AFTER THE SHOW. ALL CERTIFICATES/PAPERWORK MUST BE RECEIVED WITHIN 14 WORKING DAYS AFTER THE SHOW. PLEASE NOTE A £15 ADMINISTRATION FEE WILL BE RETAINED BY THE BSHA.**
10. Horse of the Year Show levies will not be refunded as they are payable on entries received.
11. There will be no refunds for clashes or missed classes.
12. **STABLING:** BOOKINGS ARE DIRECT WITH ADDINGTON EQUESTRIAN CENTRE - Bookings open soon.
13. **PRIZE MONEY:** Prize money must be claimed via the Prize Money Form enclosed with your entry and Back Number, additional forms will be available from the Show Office. Forms must be received by the 30th September, no exceptions! **Please note**, not all classes have Prize Money and only to 3rd place.
14. **DOPE TESTING:** Please note all Horses on the Showground may be required to be dope tested. Testing will be via blood or urine samples.
15. **DOGS:** Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and are only allowed in the car and lorry parks. Dogs are not allowed in the competition or public areas, main building, cafeteria or stable barn.
16. **COMPLAINTS:** Any objection or complaint must be made in writing and signed (no anonymous complaints will be actioned) and submitted to the Disciplinary Steward or Secretary on the day of the Incident only. Fee to lodge the complaint - £100.
17. **CONDUCT:** Respectful behaviour must be shown to all BSHA and venue staff and volunteers at all times. The venue will not tolerate disrespectful behaviour towards Bar Staff. BSHA has a **ZERO** tolerance on Drug taking on site at the Show. **Anyone found taking illegal drugs will be asked to leave the showground immediately and will forfeit any placings and Prize Money won at the Show, and the Police will be informed.**
18. **BSHA WELFARE OFFICERS:** A BSHA Welfare Officer will be in attendance. Any inappropriate treatment of any horse will be disciplined accordingly.
19. **GDPR (Data Protection):** The British Show Horse Association is committed to protecting your data. We may need to share your data with, which include but are not limited to: Venue, Affiliated Societies /Associations, Emergency Services, Press. During the Show, you may be photographed, and images may be used at a later date for promotional purposes. By entering/attending the Show, you agree to the above conditions.
20. **EXERCISE & WARM-UP AREA:** The **Clear Insurance Management** Indoor (small) arena and areas as stated on the timetable can be used. Other outdoor areas TBC. **Use of these areas is at your own risk!**

21. **STABLE WATER:** If you are stabled on the grass area, please bring extra water carriers. Taps are situated at the Lorry Park end of the stable block.
22. **FLU GUIDELINES: Addington EC Flu Regulations:** *All horses and ponies attending Addington must have a current and valid vaccination record against Equine Influenza. All horses must have been fully vaccinated within the past twelve months before arriving at the event. Horses recently vaccinated must have six clear days after the vaccination before arriving at Addington Equestrian. Please present your passports for checking when collecting your back numbers from the Show Office.*

HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW HUNTER QUALIFIERS

Classes 1-4 are for Hunters, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, to be ridden. All Riders, Owners and Producers must be Members of the British Show Horse Association, The Showing Register or Sport Horse Breeding GB. Horses must be registered with the British Show Horse Association, The Showing Register or Sport Horse Breeding GB. Entries in the weight classes may not compete in the Small Show Hunter of the Year, and vice versa. These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk. This is a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier, all data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit www.grandstandentries.com. Competitors must enter their horses in the appropriate sections, but section A will be judged first, and the judges shall have the power to transfer exhibits to section B or C if they deem it necessary. This class is a qualifying class for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 7th – 11th October 2026. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office. Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity Documents must be in the name of the legal owner **with in 30 days of ownership. This must be registered with the breed society, relevant studbook or ID issuing agency, dependant on breed/type of animal.** Spot checks may be carried out at qualifying shows and by breed societies.
